

Worley who helped make Vanderbilt University an internationally known name by mentoring hundreds of foreign government officials in the ways of economic development died Saturday after an illness. He was 77. Mr. Worley taught economics at Vanderbilt for 30 years. For a quarter-century from 1961 - 1988 he directed the universitys Graduate Program in Economic Development. The program the oldest of its kind in the United States brought officials and university professors from developing nations to Nashville to study for master's degrees in economics. When they returned to their countries many received promotions and a few became directors of their nations central banks the equivalent of this countrys Federal Reserve. Mr. Worley worked with more than 900 government officials and academics from 92 countries during his tenure. Andrea Maneschi who has taught economics at Vanderbilt since 1970 said Mr. Worley made the students feel at home and made the university look good abroad. "He was more than a mentor" said Maneschi who served two stints as the economic development programs acting director. "He was really a friend to them and almost a father figure.... He really projected Vanderbilts image overseas with this program " Mr. Worley a Birmingham AL native who earned bachelors and master's degrees from Vanderbilt is survived by his wife Rosemary and four children: Paul Worley Marian Worley Watson and Susan Morley Meador all of Nashville and Sam Worley of Chicago.
