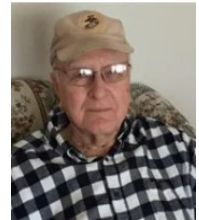

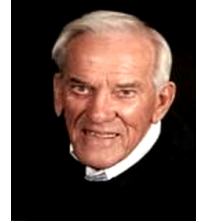

The recession of 1980-1981 created the need to downsize and liquidate various assets until sold in 1981-1983. Electra and Allied Sound Inc. remained and operated for several years. In 1989 Allied Audio Visual Services Inc. was formed to become and audio-visual rental company servicing hotels corporations and conventions with presentation equipment and personnel needs. This company was sold in 1998 and Howell retired. During his business years he served on dealer advisory boards for the 3M company Dukane Corporation Technicolor Panasonic and the Bell & Howell Corporation. 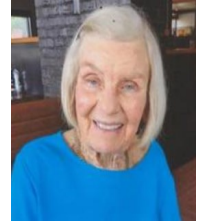

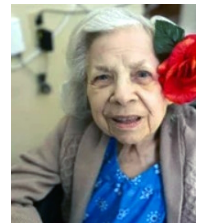

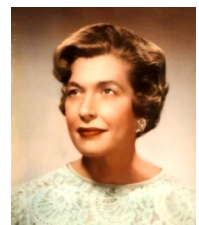
