At the time of enlistment Mack was 20 years old had 2 years of high school education and was single with dependents. One year later Mack was captured by Nazi Germany while serving in Belgium. Mack's capture was first reported to the International Committee of the Red Cross on December 22 1944 and the last report was made on October 22 1945. Based on these two reports Mack was imprisoned for at least 304 days (~11 months). The average duration of imprisonment was 363 days. Ultimately Mack was returned to military control liberated or repatriated.
