Howard Runyon Winn passed away Tuesday morning May 30 2006. In the early 1950s when the public library was built at the corner of McLean and Peabody in midtown he bought one of the houses slated for demolition and moved it to its current location on Barksdale Street. He was a past member of the East Memphis Exchange Club was a Freemason raised at the Summer Avenue Lodge and proceeded through the Scottish Rite. The organization to which he gave much of his time and attention was the Al Chymia Shrine Temple in Memphis participated in the Patrol and was president of the Chanters the Shrine choral group. He was elected Potentate in 1978 and later served as Recorder for several terms. In his later years he joined Trinity United Methodist Church where he participated in the church choir and performed cameo roles in several dinner theater productions.
