HAROLD RAY BRADLEY



Harold Bradley a kind gentle soul and the best dad and grandfather died peacefully in his sleep Thursday morning January 31 2019 at the age of 93. Known worldwide as a music icon and the most-recorded guitarist the Hall of Fame musician was foremost a dedicated family man. Harold Bradley married Eleanor Allen Bradley in 1952. Over their 66-year marriage Bradley cherished family time with his wife and two daughters saying he would practice his guitar while they went to the grocery store to have time to spend with them when they returned. Late Harold Bradley enjoyed grandchildren whom he took pride in encouraging in their own musical pursuits. Harold Ray Bradley's own pursuit in the music business will forever live on in masterful recordings that established Nashville as a recording capitol. Bradley's amazing talents can be heard on some of Elvis Presley's records and movie soundtracks. As a matter of fact that is the one star Bradley says he did ask for an autograph from but not for himself for his daughters. Bradley also recorded with such notable entertainers as Perry Como Joan Baez Buddy Holly Ivory Joe Hunter Pee Wee King George Morgan Hank Williams Burl Ives Henry Mancini Connie Francis George Beverly Shea Hank Snow Jim Reeves Charley Pride Leon Russell The Everly Brothers Gene Watson Marty Robbins Freddie Hart Conway Twitty and Roy Clark. He's played on such classic cuts as Red Foley's "Chattanooga Shoe Shine Boy " Ray Anthony's "Do the Hokey Pokey " Bobby Helms' "Jingle Bell Rock " Brenda Lee's "I'm Sorry " Roy Orbison's "Only the Lonely " Patsy Cline's "Crazy " Johnny Horton's "Battle of Now Orleans " Jimmy Dean's "Big Bad John " Roger Miller's "King of the Road " Jeannie C. Riley's "Harper Valley PTA." Tammy Wynette's "Stand By Your Man " Eddy Arnold's "Make the World Go Away " Loretta Lynn's "Coal Miner's Daughter " The Everly Brothers' "Ebony Eyes" and John Anderson's "Swinging'." Harold Bradley can boast a trio of his own albums on the Columbia label "Misty Guitar "The Bossa Nova Goes to Nashville" and "Guitar For Lovers Only." His musical input can be heard too on such other LP's as the Bear Family's ambitious four-compact disc set 'Webb Pierce The Wandering Boy 1951-1958 " and Alan Jackson's "Here In the Real World" album for Arista. Harold Bradley was born January 2 1926 in Nashville Tennessee. His older brother Owen was already playing in bands when Harold became as he says fascinated with banjo. It was Owen Bradley who advised his younger brother to learn guitar. That led to Harold Bradley landing a coveted job playing guitar with Grand Ole Opry star Ernest Tubb at the young age of 17. After high school graduation Bradley joined the Navy and was assigned to a secret radio unit called FRUPAC (Fleet Radio Unit Pacific) where he monitored the Russian and Japanese codes. Upon his discharge in 1946 Bradley a World War II veteran studied at George Peabody College under the GI Bill. To enhance his income Harold played on the Grand Ole Opry with Eddy Arnold and Bradley Kincaid. It was December 17 1946 when Harold Bradley stepped into his first recording session with Pee Wee King and the Golden West Cowboys in Chicago. Harold Bradley and his brother Owen would go on to play on Castle Studio's first recording session in Nashville in 1947. In turn Harold and his brother Owen built the first recording studio on Music Row that historians credit with starting the music industry in Nashville. The original Bradley Film and Recording Studio with the later addition of the Quonset Hut were innovative and creative studios for entertainers

worldwide. And consequentially Harold Bradley is a member of the A Team the 12 highly-respected musicians who did the bulk of Nashville recordings for 30 years. Harold Bradley has recorded or worked with 30 Rock and Roll Hall of Fame inductees and 83 Country Music Hall of Fame inductees not including himself. Harold Bradley received country music's highest honor in 2006 as he was elected to the Country Music Hall of Fame. Bradley's genuine sincerity and humbleness shown as he turned the spotlight on his fellow musicians and others he worked with in the studio giving them credit for his accomplishments during his acceptance speech. It was this loyalty and kindness that entrusted the music industry to name him the first Nashville president of the "National Academy of Recording Arts and Sciences" (NARAS) in 1965 President of the Nashville Association of Musicians Local 257 for 18 years (1991-2008) and the first local officer from Nashville to become an International officer; serving for 10 years as the International Vice President of the American Federation of Musicians of the United States and Canada (1999-2010). Bradley was also devoted to taking care of his fellow musicians testifying in copyright arbitration and FCC airplay hearings. Harold Bradley is also a proud member of the Musicians Hall of Fame North America Country Music Hall of Fame and Atlanta Hall of Fame as well as a prestigious recipient of the Grammy's Trustee Award. Beyond his musical contributions Harold Bradley had a generous spirit. Bradley was a founding member of the Music City Tennis Invitational in 1973. The benefit for Vanderbilt Children's Hospital also showcased his remarkable athleticism. He was an avid tennis player and played in the event for 30 years receiving the MCTI Sportsmanship Award in 1999. Harold Bradley was in fact a great sportsman being offered a baseball contract by the Chicago Cubs along with an expert rating as a water ski jumper and slalom skier. But Bradley especially loved playing sports with his grandchildren whether on the lake or at the pool even teaching them to play softball. He was preceded in death by his father Vernie F. Bradley; mother Letha Maie Owen Bradley; brothers Leon Bradley Owen Bradley Charles D. Bradley Bobby Gene Bradley and sister Ruby Bradley Strange. Harold Bradley is survived by his wife of 66-plus years Eleanor Allen Bradley; daughters Beverly Ellen Bradley and Bari (husband: Barry) Bradley Brooks; grandson Jason Reid Brooks; granddaughter Bethany Ellen Hill; and many nieces and nephews. William Porch Bryant Jr. passed away following a brief illness on July 3 2014 at the age of 92. "Bill" as he was known to family and friends was born at home in Nashville on Jan. 31 1926. He grew up in the Inglewood neighborhood and graduated in 1944 from Isaac Litton High School where he was a receiver for the Lion's football team. Bill was drafted into the U.S. Army on July 30 1945 just before the end of World War II. When the war ended in September 1945 he was awaiting training to be an interpreter of Japanese. After serving two years he attended the Georgia Institute of Technology on the G.I. Bill graduating in 1950 with a degree in industrial engineering. Soon afterward he began a 49-year career in the manufacturing industry working for Genesco Hardwick Mills and Henry. I. Siegel (H.I.S.). In 1963 Bill moved to the Chicago area where he worked for Sears for 25 years. His responsibilities as an industrial engineer found him traveling to various foreign locales including India and Mexico. 


