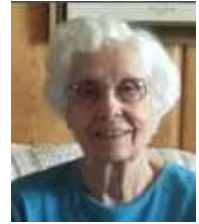

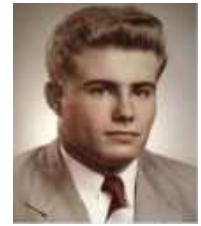

Police in Atlanta now say the New Year shooting death of Russell Weiss who was a former Nashville nightclub operator may have been a freak accident. Police Major B L Neikirk said police are treating the case as a homicide pending a final report from the Fulton County medical examiners office. Weiss age 55 who is a part-time night club food and beverage coordinator was shot about one minute past midnight amid a New Years Eve celebration at the Locomotion Restaurant and Lounge where he worked. The bullet struck him behind the ear and he died about 10 hours later. Without going into great detail the evidence suggests that the bullet that struck Russell Weiss was fired from outside the building, through the wall and that he may not have been an intended target. Investigators found a bullet hole in the wall of the club and ballistics experts said the bullet came from outside the building. They do not believe anyone could have fired the bullet from outside the building and hit anyone on purpose. Weiss was a Nashville native who left Tennessee more than 20 years ago. During the mid-1950s he operated the Paradise Club on Nolensville Road and he operated the King of Clubs nightspot on Clarksville Highway.
