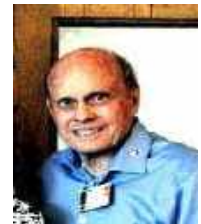

Beginning in the fall of 1971 she taught third grade at Plainview Elementary School in Rainsville Alabama. Frances's youngest son Gene was one of her students during her first year of teaching. Eventually she earned a Master of Elementary Education degree and Class AA Teacher Certification from the University of Alabama in Birmingham. In 1973 the Hinson family relocated to Fort Payne where Arnold was hired as meat market manager of the city's new Winn-Dixie store and Frances continued to teach third grade at nearby Plainview where she taught for 29 years before retiring. Throughout her life Frances was a skilled artisan in a variety of arts and crafts media including weaving ceramics basket making copper tooling nail and string art quilting gourd painting tie dying jewelry making macramé and many other types. Frances had a long-time interest in camps and won her first award at G.A. ("Girls Auxiliary") Camp at age 11. During her years in Fort Payne Frances was a member of the DeSoto Fiber Guild DeKalb Quilters and Alabama Designer Craftsmen as well as being an active participant in the ceramics group at the Fort Payne/DeKalb County Senior Center. Frances was also an excellent cook having descended from good cooks including her mother Bernice and maternal grandmother Mary Virginia "Pearle" Seymour Horner. Especially at Christmas time Frances would often prepare a variety of homemade candies such as divinity fudge pecan roll and pralines. She also cooked a variety of other dishes remember fondly by her family such as butter dips cauliflower with cheese salmon patties thickened potatoes creamed chicken on cornbread Sidney's dish eggs à la goldenrod minestrone soup tuna fish casserole brown sugar and peanut butter on toast blackberry cobbler Swiss chocolate pie buttermilk pie chocolate pudding cake homemade pancake syrup and too many other Southern and other dishes to list. Frances loved the outdoors. She and her husband Arnold brought up all of their children to have a special and deep appreciation for nature. They took their family on camping trips sometimes accompanied by cousins and friends as well. Many of the family and various friends were led by Frances and Arnold on rugged multi-day canoeing trips through the Okefenokee Swamp. After the Hinsons' four children were grown Frances and Arnold began taking cruises -- more than 25 of them -- often in the Caribbean but also in Spain and once through the Panama Canal up the west coast of Mexico. Frances had a remarkable rapport with and tender heart for dogs and cats. Her husband Arnold recalled visiting a family in a rural area where a wild cat darted across the yard perhaps to hide in a woodpile or dark corner of some outbuilding. The cat's "owner" said something like "Nobody will ever touch that cat. Can't nobody catch it!" A few minutes later Frances was petting the cat which responded to her as it had with no one else. When living in Albertville Frances's children along with some neighborhood peers found a squalling tortoise-shell-colored cat stuck in a drain pipe too scared to come out. The children tried unsuccessfully to bait the cat out with a freshly opened can of tuna. Only after Frances came onto the scene and called to the scared feline did the cat come out eventually being named Patches -- also known as "Apache" or "Mrs. Mop" as one of the family's pets. Referring to Frances's "animal whisperer skills" one of her children observed "Mom could charm a cat right out of a drainpipe!" One very special animal to Frances was a "rescued" greyhound Barbi who lived indoors and captured the hearts of both Arnold and Frances. Barbi is remembered for loving to watch and bark at cats through the home's front windows and barking silently for treats of cheese that Arnold especially would offer to Barbi. During the weeks before Frances died one of her frequent companions in her hospital bed was Little Dude a small gray cat who snuggled with Frances in exchange for petting. During the final days of Frances's life even after she

became non-responsive Little Dude was still frequently with her curled up next to her and basking in Frances's presence. On September 4 during the last few hours of Frances' life even as she was surrounded by numerous family members Little Dude continued to lay quietly cuddled next to Frances until the end. No one knows whether Frances was aware of her surroundings at the end. If so she surely would have been happy at the affirmations and expressions of love from her family. But she also surely would have been happy to have a loyal and loving cat next to her as she departed this life. 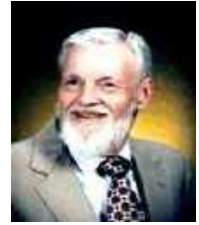
