John Sam Caldwell the curator of paintings and sculpture at the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art and a well-known advocate of contemporary art died on Sunday at Mount Sinai Hospital in Miami Beach where he had a vacation home. He was 51 and lived in San Francisco. The cause was a heart attack said Chelsea Brown the director of public relations and marketing at the museum. Mr. Caldwell was born in Nashville on Nov. 16 1941 the only child of Nathan Green Caldwell and Camilla Johnston Caldwell. His father was a Pulitzer Prize- winning journalist who wrote for The Tennessean. Mr. Caldwell earned his bachelor's degree from Harvard University in 1963 and a master's degree in art history from Hunter College in 1973. For the next three years he pursued graduate studies in 18th- and 19th-century American art history at Yale University. In 1975 he went to the Metropolitan Museum of Art as an Andrew W. Mellon Fellow and in 1977 he was named assistant curator of American art. Revived Pittsburgh International. Between 1980 and 1984 Mr. Caldwell contributed art criticism to the suburban weekly sections of The New York Times for Westchester New Jersey and Connecticut and in this period he became increasingly interested in contemporary art. In 1984 he was hired by John R. Lane the director of the Carnegie Museum of Art in Pittsburgh as adjunct curator of contemporary art; he became curator of contemporary art in 1985. Working with Mr. Lane he organized the 1985 Carnegie International a show that was widely seen as reviving interest in that 90-year-old invitational exhibition. While at the Carnegie Mr. Caldwell organized exhibitions of the work of contemporary artists like Richard Deacon Sean Scully and Joan Witek. He also acquired paintings by Anselm Kiefer and Sigmar Polke that were among the first major works by these well-known German artists to enter American museum collections. Mr. Lane who became director of the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art in 1987 named Mr. Caldwell curator of painting and sculpture in 1989. The program that Mr. Caldwell instigated for San Francisco was an astute mixture of underappreciated and high-profile artists. In the last year for example he assembled a retrospective of the works of Luciano Fabro an Italian Arte Povera artist who is not well known in this country and a survey of the work of the American artist Jeff Koons. He also organized a widely acclaimed retrospective of Mr. Polke's work that toured the United States in 1990 and organized an exhibition of younger artists including Sherrie Levine Martin Kippenberger Christopher

Wool and Matthew Barney. Although Mr. Caldwell was sometimes criticized for his emphasis on European and New York art he and Mr. Lane were often credited with bringing new life and international visibility to the museum which is constructing a new building designed by Mario Botta in downtown San Francisco. Mr. Caldwell contributed to the design of the galleries in this building which is to open in January 1995 and was working on plans for the inaugural exhibition and the installation of the permanent collection.



The following is the eulogy preached at her funeral. Keep on loving one another as Christian sisters and brothers. Remember to

welcome strangers into your homes. There were some who did that and welcomed angels unaware. Remember those who are in prison as though you were in prison with them. Remember those who are suffering as though you were suffering as they are. Remember your leaders those who spoke to you the word of God; consider the outcome of their life and imitate their faith. (Hebrews 13:1-3 7) MaryRuth died in the early morning hours of the 3rd Sunday of Advent. Like Mary whose name she carried MaryRuth had been waiting and vigiling: at home in worship under the beam of radiation in the clinic at Emory Hospital and finally in the Intensive Care Unit. Well now that you mention it I think you could say MaryRuth had always waited and vigiled. So it is with pilgrims. Her name was Mary derivation of the Hebrew Miriam: Mary — meaning Rebellion. MaryRuth — Rebellion? Yes Rebellion. Ruth (again from Hebrew) means kindness. Kindness — yes! Her name is Rebellious Kindness— think about it. She was kindness. She was kindness in rebellion against all that was unkind. They met MaryRuth and Ed in the Vanderbilt University library. Exactly how they met in the library depends on whether you asked MaryRuth Ed or Eduard Loring. Many of us in this gathering know and understand something about “the expansive nature of the facts of history.” Anyway they met they fell in love and they married. For 43 good years they practiced love they shared love they offered love they discovered and re-discovered love — the Radical nature of Love the Radical claim of love word only: Enough. She had had enough and on their lives. They began a pilgrimage. It’s hard to realize that when they left Nashville Tennessee for Washington D.C. MaryRuth went to work for the CIA and Ed for the National Security Agency! He was a code breaker; she was a librarian. But the Radical Gospel claim of Love in their lives would not let them stand still. They became pilgrims. They searched for a way of life that would embody the love that lived in them and moved them forward. Over the years they bore children and loved each one to life: Dawn Rachel Bill and Sabrina. Their love overflowed and led them to Koinonia — reconciling community. Intentional Christian community. Disciplined community. Radical Gospel practicing community. Justice-seeking community. Agitating movement building community. Community: seeking racial justice, an end to war and the abolition of the death penalty. Don Moseley remembers how community members raised their eyebrows suspiciously when these two showed up wanting to join the Koinonia Community — from the CIA and the NSA?! But join they did and vocation for MaryRuth and Ed began to narrow and focus. On to be among the founders of Jubilee Partners Community and another mission: welcoming the displaced and the uprooted nation-less brothers and sisters. Welcoming strangers on this good land entertaining angels again and again. Her love overflowed the boundaries. In Sumter County and then in Madison County some 40 more babies came into her loving arms — children displaced from their own families into state foster care. And each child found a respite a place of love and kindness with MaryRuth and her family. Love moved them again: on to found New Hope House. MaryRuth and Ed and Sabrina were blessed and sent out from worship in this very room at Jubilee seventeen years ago. New hope for the families and friends of death row. New hope for the condemned and their families so very alone in courts of condemning laws. And there at New Hope House their love and MaryRuth’s rebellious kindness made a home. She welcomed Joe Brunet wed to Dawn. She welcomed Mari Ohta wed to Bill. Then with suitcases packed and ready she welcomed each beloved child: Taro Shogo Jesse Nicholas Grace Marie Miriam (aha! Another Rebel!) Brendan. What a joy the children were every

day to this kind grandmother this Kind Rebel! But her love was never to be confined to the strictures of biological family alone. She believed ever more deeply that her faith in Jesus the Executed Middle Eastern Jew pushed her — shy quiet MaryRuth who never ever sought the limelight who preferred always to work behind the scenes. Her Radical love pushed her ever farther into her name which became her destiny: to actively Rebel against the cruelty the profound un-Kindness of Execution and the institution of the Death Penalty. She carried the sorrow in her great and kind heart and in her hand a clipboard and a stack of cards. “Have you signed a card to ask for a moratorium on the death penalty in Georgia? Well I just have one right here and a pen and you may use my clipboard. I would like to take it with me now.” Day after day in front of the Capitol in church in meetings at demonstrations on street corners even through the car window at stoplights: Stop the Death Penalty. Agitate and cry out for a moratorium on executions. Rebel for the sake of kindness and love. But death came knocking too soon. Too cruel is our loss. We all began our deep grief journeying with her at the end of the summer as it wore on to the fall. But MaryRuth the Kind Rebel took on a distinct radiance. She was never afraid. She fought to live she wanted to live but she was never ever afraid to die. But then back to ICU and the early hours of Advent MaryRuth had been in labor for a long long long time. Rachel and Ed had worked heroically as her primary midwives. But she knew it was time for the labor to be done and time for the Great Birth to proceed. It had been many hours since she had spoken a word but with her last strength she pushed back the mask that had been pushing oxygen into her weary lungs and she said to Ed — her beloved Butch — and Ed knew it was true. She was weary. She was spent. She had struggled long and with great courage and contagious peace. But her labor was done and she was not afraid. Perhaps she was even eager in a way to take the next long step. And so the mask was removed. And we sang and wept and prayed and laughed and talked. She breathed for another five hours or so and then she was done. She left us — as she had lived among us — way behind the scenes out of the limelight no fanfare. Her last word was to her Ed. She said “Enough.” She knew and trusted that he would help her on her journey as they had faithfully helped each other for 43 years. She leaves it now to us the people of the Resurrection people of the Movement for Justice and Human Dignity. She will live — in her beloved Ed in her beautiful children and much loved grandchildren. She will live in each and all of us — her community — as we take up her mantle. And her deep and abiding faith in the God of Love is ours to share. MaryRuth — Kind Rebel — you will live as we move and struggle toward a Moratorium on the Death Penalty (and it will come). You will live as this cruelty is finally abolished for all time (and it will be). You will live as we welcome strangers and entertain angels in our own homes (may it always be so). You will live as the lion lies down with the lamb and war is no more (and yes peace even in this world of hideous and unceasing warfare will come). You will live as we remember those in prison as though we were in prison with them (we will remember and remembering we will act). You will live as we take up your mantle and your faith (ah may we take it up each day). You will live MaryRuth Kind Rebel — you will live! Murphy Davis is a Partner at the Open Door Community. 

His engaging personality and social skills partnered well with his gift for mathematics and visionary entrepreneurship. Joe was a calculator with feet. Elan was a top supplier of footwear to Walmart and many other national and international retailers for decades. The company became Elan-Polo upon entering the Asia markets. Joe also served as Chair of the FDRA, Footwear Distributors and Retailers of America. Joe traveled the world extensively throughout his career but always preferred to be at home with his wife and family. His solution was to take them with him as much as possible. His early days in India and other countries were spent manufacturing woven leather fashion footwear for popular prices and discount retailers and provided an education he could not obtain in any business school. 
