She was ever present at her grandchildren’s special events a reliable supporter of all of their fundraisers and interests the safe place everyone landed when sick or hurt or just visiting from out of town the creator of many family traditions that will live on a confidant who her daughters could call for anything (a phone call with her was like a good therapy session) and a loyal friend to many. Being all of those things brought her the greatest joy. Countless hours were spent compiling family recipes planning for reunions journalist for her grandchildren keeping organized albums of family photos recording every important event of anyone else on her wall calendar (and always remembered to ask them about it later) or putting thoughtful notes with every keepsake in her house so her family would know its history when she could no longer remember. Everything she did was a gift for others. When she wasn’t caring for her family she was often tending to her houseplants or flowers listening to her favorite music watching football visiting antique stores to search for her favorite Disney character Goofy taking road trips to her husband’s hometown and enjoying movies with heartfelt story lines which she’d always recommend to someone who she knew would appreciate it. Her meals were simple but everything she cooked was made with love and became instant favorites which is reflective of many other things she did. She knew how to turn the ordinary into extraordinary. Becky grew up in East Nashville where her father was a home builder and her family attended Lockeland Baptist Church. She had many fond memories of playing in Shelby Park and around the Lockeland Springs neighborhood with her siblings and neighbors’ children. She graduated from Isaac Litton High School served as a Sunday school teacher at her church and had a long career at Bell South where she retired in 1987. She made friends everywhere she went and remembered everyone by name from the hair salon to restaurants she frequented and some of her most cherished friends were those she worked with. She married the love of her life William (“Bill”) Edward Creasy on May 27 1980 and was the most loyal and devoted companion one could ask for. 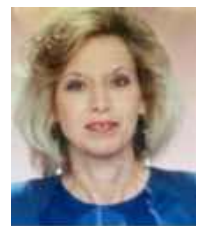

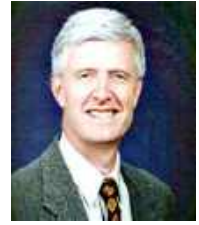

Linda Schele a onetime studio art teacher who made a fateful vacation visit to Mexico that turned her life upside down and helped revolutionize Mayan scholarship died on Saturday at a hospital near her home in Austin Tex. She was 55 and widely known for her pioneering work in decoding inscriptions on Mayan monuments. A native of Nashville who obtained a bachelor's degree in education and a master's in fine arts from the University of Cincinnati in 1968 Dr. Schele (SHE-lee) was more or less contentedly teaching studio art at the University of South Alabama in Mobile when her husband a Cincinnati-trained architect who had long been fascinated with pre-Columbian architecture suggested that the couple spend their 1970 Christmas vacation visiting Mayan ruins in Mexico. A woman of infectious enthusiasm Dr. Schele who had no special interest in the Mayan civilization threw herself into the project securing a grant to take photographs for the university collection and recruiting three art students for the trip. As the travelers began their tour they were persuaded to make a slight detour from their itinerary to spend a couple of hours visiting the ruins at the Mayan city of Palenque. When they got there Dr. Schele was so taken with the breathtaking beauty of the site and so enthralled by the scholars she encountered there that the 2-hour visit stretched to 12 days. By the time she got back to Mobile she had a new life's work. She remained at South Alabama until she had obtained a doctorate in Latin American studies from the University of Texas and became a professor of art there in 1981 but Dr. Schele spent virtually every spare moment at Palenque and other Mayan sites. Although the Mayans who flourished from about A.D. 200 to 900 had long been recognized for their scientific work in devising a calendar based on advanced astronomical observations they had been largely dismissed by scholars as sort of idiot savants an illiterate nation of indolent stargazers who devoted all their considerable mathematical and intellectual resources simply to marking time. They were also seen as a blissfully peaceful people whose fabled cities lacked even rudimentary fortifications. As for the abundant carvings and glyphs on the countless monuments among the ruins scholars had assumed these were variously religious symbols or arcane notations denoting the movement of planets. The view had persisted even though a 16th century Spanish priest had done important though long-ignored work suggesting that the glyphs constituted an actual language and though a spate of recent work derided by established scholars had even worked out the syntax of the language in which individual glyphs represented syllables of complex words. It was at a meeting of scholars at Palenque in 1973 that Dr. Schele emerged as a leader of a revisionist school of Mayan scholarship. When it was suggested that she and a young Calgary University student at the meeting Peter Matthews try to translate the inscriptions on the monuments at Palenque it took the pair only three hours to discover that the inscriptions provided an incredibly detailed history of the Palenque dynasty. Over the next dozen years Dr. Schele and others deciphered and interpreted inscriptions throughout the Mayan realm but it was not until 1986 when Dr. Schele helped organize an exhibition at the Kimbell Art Museum in Fort Worth that the world learned the full implications of the work: Far from being an ethereal peaceful people the Mayans were a warring nation who tortured and sometimes sacrificed

their captives whose nobles engaged in blood-letting rituals to placate their gods and whose king was required to stick a rod through the shaft of his own penis on ceremonial occasions. A scholar who shared her own research generously and who organized annual conferences that became a focus of Mayan research Dr. Schele collaborated on a series of important books among them *The Blood of Kings* 1986 Braziller *A Forest of Kings* 1990 Morrow *Maya Cosmos* 1993 Morrow and *The Code of Kings* 1998 Scribner. In recent years the woman who helped decipher a language and discover a history of a once mighty civilization had held workshops to teach the Mayan descendants how to read the language of their ancestors. Her husband David said the cause of death was pancreatic cancer. In addition to her husband Dr. Schele is survived by a brother Tom Richmond of Chicago. Services to be held Wednesday at 7:00 pm at Amey Funeral Home in Austin.
