***For me cerebral palsy is just a pesky little mosquito that I have to keep from biting me too many times. My life has been an enjoyable one *** (John Storrs - In His Own Words). Life was a full one for John. He loved cats. Finding his voice he became a dedicated poet. He was an early adopter of computers and the internet. Searching through baseball cards John built a stellar collection along

with satisfaction. An appreciation of music inspired him. He wrote lyrics that were put to songs. Many hours of family time were spent playing games and cards and John was an excellent chess player. His life expressed an incredible determination, drive, and a great sense of humor. With Johnny's eagerness he could ride a tricycle at age six, and then walking when he was seven years old. This was the beginning of making the most of life situations. He was chosen for the Tennessee Easter Seal Child in 1956. David Crocket became more real as ***I wore a coon skin cap that Fess Parker let me put on. I played on Andrew Johnson's piano and held his walking stick. *** A happy camper was the result within Johnny during each of the three years he attended Camp-Chee-Chee for Crippled Children and Adults. First Johnny started his academic time in a special class for cerebral palsy students at Buena Vista School in Nashville. Acceptance to Dalewood School put John into regular classes for third grade. Thelma Gilliam principal laid the groundwork for understanding and acceptance from his peers. John became a graduate in 1966 from Isaac Litton High School. During this time he was also football manager for state champion Litton Lions. At home John would practice running in the backyard so he could proudly enter the football field with his team. ***It was time for me to ask. As I walked out of class I thought to myself "Was I really going into Litton's football locker room? Coach Hewitt was working at his desk. When he saw me he asked "Johnny can I help you?" It took me all of five minutes before I could get the words out ... "I want to be a football manager." Those were some of the hardest that I had ever spoken because I wanted to be a part of Litton's football team so much. Coach Hewitt waited until I had finished and then he smiled "OK Johnny I have a job for you to start." With those words Coach Hewitt went and got 50 helmets for me to clean. They were all lined up and one by one I cleaned those dirty helmets the best I could. I must have done a good job because that started the best four years of my life. *** Collecting autographs was John's way to connect with others and to history. He produced a set of his presidential paintings with the works being autographed by the Presidents themselves. ***It was October 1964 when President Lyndon Johnson was campaigning for a full four year term as President. I heard that he was coming to Nashville on a campaign stop so I decided to try and get his autograph. I thought it would be very difficult at best. I was going to try. After geometry I just calmly walked to the Principal's office and asked to see him. I told him that I wanted to play hooky and go to town to get Johnson's autograph. He smiled and gave me his OK. I carried an old LIFE magazine with my drawing of the President inside. Once on the bus I reasoned that everyone would be crowded around the War Memorial Building to hear the President's speech. I thought the best thing for me to do would be to go to the Hermitage Hotel where President Johnson was to have lunch and where I could find a spot to stand and just let the President come to me. I got to town. Nashville looked like a mad ant farm at war. When I reached the Hermitage Hotel door everyone was coming out while I wanted in. No one was stopping me. I hunted for a kind looking policeman. When I found one I calmly asked him "Where is the Secret Service?" He quickly answered without looking at me "Sixth floor Room 613." I found the corridor surprisingly empty. I knocked at Room 613. Then the door quickly opened and a well-built man was reaching for his gun. A voice from the back of the room shouted "Get that boy out of here!" Two policemen took me by both arms and escorted me to the elevator. I was back at the lobby. During all my adventures in the Hermitage President Johnson had made his speech and was making his way to the hotel. I saw the President and I tried to hold up my drawing of him. But the influx of reporters and photographers was so great that I was knocked to the floor. I was not hurt but I couldn't get up. Thankfully our Congressman recognized me and helped me up. I decided to wait some more. The elevator opened and the mob scene started all over again. The President was walking directly toward me with a nice smile. He stopped where I was and shook my somewhat trembling hand. "Hello Johnny." He then added "I understand you want my autograph." He signed

his name on the portrait and then he calmly walked on. I looked at Johnson's autograph. I buttoned my football jacket and put the drawing of our President of the United States back in the LIFE magazine. This was my proof that the impossible was possible! *** John spent 11 years at Belmont College taking a course one at a time then graduated with honors a BS degree in 1977 for history and again in 1980 with a BA in English. Each time Mark Richardson assisted John so he could walk the stage for his diplomas. Later John served as Mark's best man. ***I didn't like that sloppy grad-cap! It got stabbed so many times with bobby-pins that the poor cap couldn't get away from the top of my head. But the cap took its revenge by whipping my nose with its tassel. *** John was among those listed in "Who's Who in American Universities and Colleges." Other friends included Johnny Edwards who provided many fun capers. In 1977 John was invited by Professor Helen Midkiff to accompany the Belmont Choir to Italy. There he met Merry Cox who played handbells with her South Carolina church. John and Mary became fast friends and remained so until his death. Following his mother's death John lived independently in his home on Music Row for over ten years. Afterwards he moved to assisted living at Belmont Morningside and The Meadows in Bellevue. Death claimed him by aspiration pneumonia. *** What if God were a dog? He would come to find me and race me home. But when I fall He comes to where I lie And putting His cold nose to my cheek He tickles my tears away; He is telling me to follow. And because of love - I follow... ***
